DISCIPLINE PLAN Bowman High School

The Bowman High School Discipline Plan has been developed by teachers, students, parents, the school counselors, and administration. It has been built on the foundation that:

**ALL STUDENTS HAVE THE RIGHT TO LEARN
ALL TEACHERS HAVE THE RIGHT TO TEACH**

Any behavior which weakens or destroys this process cannot and will not be tolerated.

The following is a general list of behaviors which are considered detrimental to the TEACHING-LEARNING process.

<u>Behavior</u>	<u>Consequences</u>
A. Excessive, disruptive, non-violent actions within one class period (examples: constant talking, bothering others, giggling, sleeping, drumming on desk top, etc.)	Teacher warning, student sent to office for a "TIME-OUT" ...behavior discussed with counselor or administrator.
B. Any repeat of the above, leaving class without permission, throwing paper or other non-injurious objects, continual argumentation.	Final warning, detention assigned by teacher...or class suspension.
C. Defiance of teacher directions, continued conversations involving topics such as drugs, sex, vulgarity, alcohol, gang activities, continued class disruption, violation of special class rules (usually safety concerns.)	Teacher sends student to office for class suspension from that class...teacher makes parent contact, multiple offenses may result in out of school suspension.
D. Any of the above behaviors or special problems/concerns.	May be referred to the counselor or administrator at any time.
E. Any violent behavior or possible violent behavior such as fighting, threats, vulgarity (directed at teacher/staff member), destruction of school/personal property.	Direct referral to an administrator...could result in detention, 1-5 day suspension, referral to Sheriff's department, recommendation to expel, transfer to adult school, parent conference.
F. Direct refusal to leave classroom when ordered to do so by teacher.	Out-of-school suspension.

- G. Smoking on school campus
1st offense – detention or a one day suspension.
2nd offense – 1 day suspension.
Additional offenses - progressive suspension.
- H. Cheating, copying work.
Teacher contacts parent, referral to counselor, 0 for assignment.
Repeat offense - 0 for assignment, referral to administrator for class drop, suspension from school.
- I. Possession/influence of drugs, alcohol, controlled substances.
Five day suspension, possible arrest, probable recommendation for expulsion.
- J. Tardiness.
#4 = Warning
#5 = 1 detention (student signs referral & letter/phone call home)
#10 = 2 detentions (same as above)
#15 = 5 detentions (schedule/program/shift change/referral)
- K. Use of Walkman, Discman, or other headphone devices in classrooms.
Confiscation by administrator.
