



WHAT IS THE YES PROGRAM?

The Youth Employment Services (YES) program provides high-risk, low-income, and special education teens, ages 14-18 years old, with job employment and job skills training.

HOW DO I KNOW IF I QUALIFY?

Teens, 14-18 years old, who are involved in any of the following:

- Participate in Special Education programs at school (Resource/Emotional Dist. classes)
- Live in a low-income home (receive a modified lunch program, single parent)
- Considered at-risk (low grades, on probation, received truancy tickets)

HOW MUCH WILL I EARN?

Teens earn \$8.00 an hour, and gain job experience, such as customer service, operating a cash register, stocking merchandise, and supervising children. Throughout the program, teens attend various skill-building workshops organized by City staff, which increases their employability.

WHEN IS THE YES PROGRAM OFFERED?

Fall School Semester – September through December

Spring School Semester – February through May

Summer Session – June through August

WHEN ARE THE YES APPLICATIONS AVAILABLE?

Fall School Semester – August

Spring School Semester – December

Summer Session – April
