MODERNIZATION SAFETY INFORMATION

Attention Students and Parents:

This summer you may have noticed that our Modernization Construction project began with the Administration and 500 buildings. We expect these projects to be completed by the time school begins. However, the next phase of construction will begin on August 15th, which includes the 300, 400, and 1100 (library) buildings. Please discuss safety with your students during our construction this school year. They need to always stay away from any areas that are fenced off and will receive consequences for ignoring signs and fences that are placed for their safety. Additionally, please discuss with them the importance of listening to adult instructions regarding any construction on campus. This is something that will be discussed at the PE Talks with the Assistant Principals.

In order to ensure student safety in crossing Stillmore Street before and after school, we begin enforcing some strict safety guidelines the very first day of school.

Students will be allowed to cross Stillmore ONLY in one of three places:

1. The signal at Whites Canyon and Stillmore
2. The stop sign at Camp Plenty and Stillmore
3. The middle of Stillmore - Crossing at the entrance of the U-Driveway at the front of school over to the apartment office building across the street. A campus supervisor is stationed in and around this area but is not able to cross the students. Students need to be cautious and look both ways before crossing.

Do NOT ask your child to dash across the street to your car without using one of the appropriate crossing areas. **Please take notice of the crossing areas on Stillmore and drive cautiously to ensure child safety.**

Only handicapped persons and school personnel should be entering the U-drive at any time.

Parent volunteers will be present the first week of school to help familiarize you with the drop-off procedures at the front of the school. Please be courteous and follow their directions, pulling all the way up the curb to allow others to come in behind you and ask your child to be ready to quickly get out of the car so you can be on your way, allowing others to come in.

We apologize if this creates any inconvenience however our utmost concern is every students' safety. Please feel free to make arrangements to pick your student up in another location if you wish to avoid these crossing areas.

Please explain to your student that this is for THEIR safety!
