IMPORTANT INFORMATION On Skateboards/Scooters, Cell Phones and Electronic Devices

Skateboards and Scooters:

Sierra Vista STRICTLY enforces the “NO SKATEBOARDS and SCOOTERS” policy.

- Students with skateboards on campus will have their skateboard confiscated until a parent/guardian can come in to the school (during business hours) to pick it up. Skateboards not picked up will be held for one month and then donated. **It is the student’s responsibility to inform their parent it needs to be picked up.** The school will not call a parent before the board is donated.

We at Sierra Vista, and the surrounding community members, appreciate your understanding.

Cell Phones:

If your student will need to have a cell phone on campus, please fill out the Cell Phone Request Form that was included in your summer mailing packet or pick one up at the ASB office. You will need to have it with you on your kick-off day so that the proper marking can be placed on your ID card. Please be sure your parent/guardian has signed the form!

If you at any time later in the year need to add the ability to have a cell phone on campus, please go to the ASB office as soon as possible. You will receive a sticker for your ID card granting permission for use of a cell phone on campus. **Please note the consequences for improper use of cell phones on campus before signing the form. Phones will be confiscated if utilized in school buildings and privileges can be revoked if there is a continual problem.**

Electronic Devices:

Electronic Devices (i.e. IPODS, MP3 players, PSP’s, etc.) are strictly prohibited on-campus and are major targets for thieves. Students should never for ANY reason have these items on-campus. Should a student be found in possession of these items, the item will be confiscated and kept in the office **until a parent can come in to pick them up** during school business hours (7:00 a.m. – 3:30p.m. and 7:00 a.m. – 12 noon on minimum days). Students who repeatedly have these items confiscated can earn consequences, including suspension from school. Please note, should your student bring these items to school, the school nor district is responsible for any loss, damage or theft to the items and school personnel will NOT be able to investigate these losses or thefts. Additionally, items confiscated by school personnel that are then mistakenly given to a person claiming to be there for that item or that are lost are not our responsibility and will not be refunded by the school as they should not have been here in the first place.
